MOTION #05/14/25 – Moved by Member Gura and supported by Member Radyko that the Chippewa Valley Schools Board of Education conducted a hearing on May 19, 2025, in a closed session concerning the Administration's recommended expulsion of Student, 05/19/2025;WYD01.

The Student and the Student's parents were advised, in writing, of the charges against the Student, the Administration's recommendation of permanent expulsion and all other due process rights required by the law and District policy.

The Board of Education, based on evidence introduced at the hearing, concluded Student 05/19/2025-WYD01 violated Sections IV.28 of the Student Code of Conduct, entitled, "*Physically Assaulting a Staff Member/Student/Person Associated with the District.*" The Board of Education, based on evidence introduced at the hearing, concluded Student 05/19/2025-WYD0 1 violated Sections IV 28 of the Student Code of Conduct, entitled, "*Physically Assaulting a Staff Member/Student/Person Associated with the District, "Section IV17, "Gross Misbehavior," Section IV42, "Verbally Threatening a Staff Member/Student/Person Associated with the District and a violation of MCL 380.1311a(1) and (2)."*"

The Board of Education also considered the following factors and concluded the Administration had rebutted the presumption against long-term suspension or expulsion: the Student's age; the Student's disciplinary history; whether the Student is disabled; the seriousness of the Student's misconduct; whether the Student's misconduct threatened the safety of any other student or staff member; whether restorative practices will be used to address the Student's misconduct; and, whether a lesser intervention would properly address the Student misconduct.

THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED: Student 05/19/2025-WYD01 is permanently expelled from the Chippewa Valley School District and is prohibited from entering any premises owned, operated or controlled by the District or attending any District-related function.

A roll call vote was taken. Member Gura, yes; Member Radyko, yes; Member Wojtowicz, yes; Member Kuntz, yes; Member Mahome, yes Member Aquino, yes and Member Pearl, yes.
