RATIONALE: Section 624 of the Revised School Code, as amended, requires intermediate school districts to submit a proposed budget to constituent school districts by May 1<sup>st</sup> of each year for the next fiscal year and requires constituent school districts, by resolution, to indicate support or disapproval of the proposed budget for the next fiscal year of the intermediate school district by June 1<sup>st</sup> of each year. Chippewa Valley Schools received the proposed budget of MCISD prior to May 1<sup>st</sup>.
