Executive Board

Student government Officers (4) elected by the student body; Appointed Positions = 4

Goal – to develop overall program and first line management, oversee the Senate and Student Council.

Student Senate

6 members per grade level and Executive Board = 32 members

Goal – to coordinate, plan and work on all school activities sponsored by the Student Government; voice class concerns, set goals for the year, approve expenditures of funds.

Student Council

1 Representative per first hour class = approximately 65 members

Goal- to develop two-way communication between first hour classes, organizations, and Student Government, allow input on issues concerning the student body.

Senior Class – 5 Class Officers with 1 Senate Representative + Council Members

Junior Class – 4 Class Officers with 2 Senate Representatives + Council Members

Sophomore Class – 4 Class Officers with 2 Senate Representatives + Council Members

Freshman Class – 6 Class Representatives for Senate + Council Members

Goal-to plan and work on class activities, homecoming activities, fund raising, building beautification, and community service projects by grade level
