Chippewa Valley Schools Construction Projects Update: July 23, 2025

Glass/Glazing

Clinton Valley Elementary – DCA is complete with replacing all the classroom window blinds with roller shades.

Mohawk Elementary – Hewett Company is complete with replacing the old skylights and installed the new skylight system over the media center.

Dakota High School – Preferred Glass is complete with replacing the remainder of the glass block windows with translucent panels.

Roofing

Sequoyah Elementary – Versatile Commercial is 95% complete with replacing the balance of flat roof. They will finish the last section before the end of July.

Seneca Middle School – Versatile Commercial is nearing completion of replacing a portion of the flat roof (3 classroom wings, kitchen, etc). Work is scheduled to be completed by the end of July.

Mechanical

Wyandot Middle Schools – a replacement rooftop chiller has been ordered and contract issued to replace the unit.

Chippewa Valley High School – K&S Ventures is continuing work on replacing the pool boilers. The old boilers have been removed and the new boilers have been delivered. Work is scheduled to be complete in August.

Central Kitchen – Danboise Mechanical & Ainsworth Electric are complete with replacing the old steam kettle with new hot water kettles.

Electrical

Wyandot Middle School – Great Lakes Power will replace the emergency generator later this year.

Site Work

Dakota High School – Asphalt Specialist started replacing the student parking lot south of the stadium. Removal is complete. Work is scheduled to resume this week and be complete by the end of July.
