2025 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION REPORT FORM

Friends of Macomb Township... A Community Foundation this year will again be awarding ten \$1,000 one-time only scholarships in June to graduating Macomb Township resident high school seniors who plan to attend a higher education or a career/technical institution or an apprenticeship program for the 2025-2026 school year.

Applications are available from February 3 through March 14th of 2025 to all **graduating high school seniors who are residents of Macomb Township**. Applications can be obtained at many nearby high schools, the main township government office, Macomb Parks and Rec Center, the Foundation website at www.friendsofmacombtownship.org, and from Mr. Cynowa. **Completed hard copies of the application, essay, transcripts, and two letters of recommendation from references chosen by the applicant must be received no later than 6:00 p.m. on March 14th by postal delivery or in person at the residence of:**

The applications will be judged by a five-member Scholarship Committee. To help ensure fairness, names will be blackened out on the judges' copies of the applications. All legitimate scholarship applicants will be first informed in May along with the media and their schools as to the selected scholarship award recipients.

CRITERIA

To be eligible to apply and compete for a scholarship, applicants must meet all of the following criteria:

1. Must be **a legal resident of Macomb Township** at the time of submitting the application;
2. Must currently be a graduating senior at the high school level;
3. Should have a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher based upon a 4.0 scale; and
4. Cannot be an immediate or extended family member of a FofMT Board Director or Officer.

APPLICATION REVIEW FACTORS

In reviewing the scholarship applications, the Scholarship Committee will consider the following factors:

1. The applicant's academic record as evidenced by an **official current transcript through the first semester of your senior year**.
2. The applicant's community service record;
3. The applicant's participation in extracurricular activities;
4. The applicant's work experiences;
5. Special awards or recognitions earned/achieved by the applicant;
6. Other scholarships received by the applicant;
7. The applicant's recommendation by **letters from two references**;
8. The effectiveness of an **essay written by the applicant**; and
9. Any extraordinary circumstances or difficulties the applicant faced or faces.

It is the applicant's responsibility to make certain that all parts of the application have been received by Mr. Cynowa, including the letters of reference and grade transcript, by March 14th.

List any work/job experiences you have had by naming where you worked, your role, and the year(s) involved.

(Activities/Work Experiences worth up to 30 points.)

List any special awards or recognitions you have earned/achieved by name, reason, and the year(s) involved.

List any other scholarships you have received or been awarded by name, duration and amount.

(Awards/Recognitions/Scholarships worth up to 5 points.)

PERSONAL ESSAY

Using not more than two typed pages attached to this application, please submit an effective, typed essay describing yourself, your personal and career goals, and what lessons/values you have learned from your education and life experiences to date. Convince us as to why you should be a recipient of this scholarship award. (Essay worth up to 20 points.)
