HOW IT WORKS:

- Use this form below to request the amount of ticket books you would like and we will send those home with your student within 48-72 hours, or sooner if we are able to do it.
- All sold ticket stubs and payments MUST be returned prior to receiving additional tickets.
- Those returning sold tickets should include the completed ticket stubs and money in a <u>sealed envelope</u> marked PTO-RAFFLE <u>no later than **Friday**, **April 18th**</u>. Pursuant to new District Guidelines for collecting money, checks are preferred. Please make checks payable to Ojibwa PTO. Returned or bounced checks will be assessed a \$20 fee. Tickets received after this date will be included in the Raffle, but will not count toward personal/classroom sales incentives.

INCENTIVES:

- Each student that sells 1 book of tickets will be entered to be 1 of 10 students decorating Mr. K in something fun (and messy) at the Carnival!
- The class with the highest percentage of participation will have the PTO Treat Trolley visit their class and their teacher will also receive a special appreciation gift!
- Top selling student will receive a \$25 Gift Card, 2nd highest student will earn an Owala water bottle, 3rd highest student will earn a \$10 Gift Card.
