Daily Schedule

- 7:15 school opens enter Door 7
- 7:30 students may enter through pod doors (Report to cafeteria)
- 7:58 students allowed in locker areas
- 8:05 first hour begins
- 2:49 end of day

Daily Schedule

- Six class periods per day
 - 6th grade core classes in the same area (6th grade pod)
 - 6th grade lockers located in 6th grade pod.
- 5 minute passing time
- Daily lunch approx. 30 min.(all 6th graders in lunch)

Four Core Classes

- Math
 - Accelerated Math (placement based on test scores)
- Language Arts
- Science
- Social Studies

Two Exploratory Classes

- Year-long Options

- Semester-length Classes
 - Passport to Success (all 6th Graders take)
